

Bingo Update Moose Charities



#### Moose Charities Update 10/11/21 – 12/9/21

During this bimonthly newsletter reporting period, we collected a total of \$2,189.99 for Moose Charities.

Of this total, \$547.92 came from Bank on Our Kids, \$157.07 came from 9 o'clock ceremonies, \$1,422 came from bingo, and \$55 came from individual donations.

Barely into the second half of the 2021 – 2022 fiscal year, we have already exceeded our +\$1.00 year-over-year quota of giving to Moose Charities. Therefore, with Board of Officers approval granted on 11/18/21, all bingo charity money will be given to local organizations through the remainder of the year.

November's bingo money totaled \$973. In addition, we had \$5,507 for charitable giving raised from Queen of Hearts drawings, yielding a total of \$6,480 between the two. The Board of Officers has authorized disbursement of these funds in the form of \$720 to each of nine local charities that we have supported with donation dinners in the past. I cut the checks on 12/8/21 with the intent of distributing them before Christmas.

Happy New Year 2022! May 2022 bring nothing but good to each of you and our great Moose fraternity.
