




Membership Retention



Bingo Update Moose Charities



Happy New Year to one and all! May we be blessed with a much better year in 2021 than 2020.

November was a record-breaking month for bingo with 106 players raising \$641. November 23rd saw a single day record of \$172 raised. October was outstanding as well, with 66 players raising \$664. On December 7th – the last bingo games before the editor's deadline for this newsletter – 23 players raised \$142.

2020 – 2021 year-to-date through 12/7/20: 436 players have raised \$2,487. We are also doing very well with our Endowment Fund banks. 2020 – 2021 year-to-date through 12/7/20, you have turned in banks totaling \$2,024.19, for a total of \$4,511.19 between bingo and banks.
