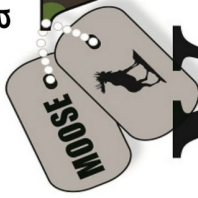

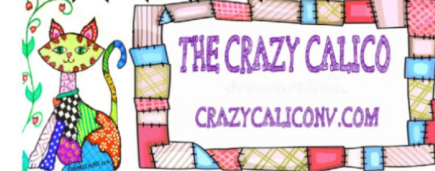

Let's all work together to make our lodge and chapter something to be proud of. Enough for now, may the Supreme Being keep us all safe and above all healthy Jim Cornell

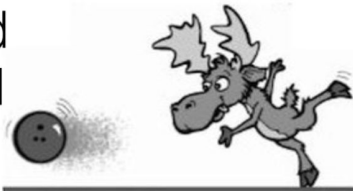
From the Senior Regent

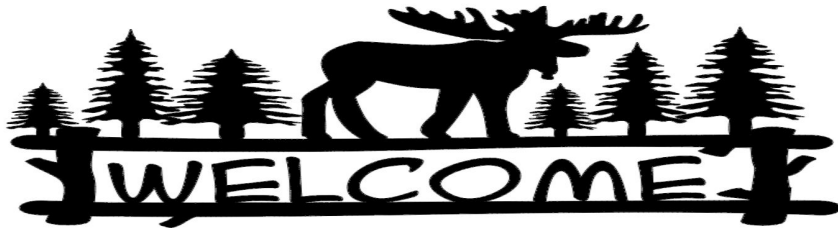

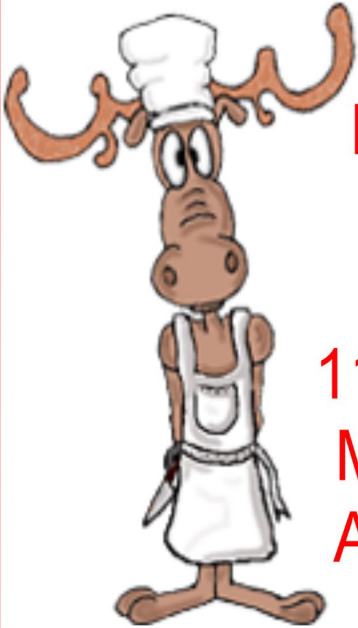
