I will be serving as your governor until June 30 because of the Covid-19 virus. The officers for the present year will also serve until June 30. The Lodge officers are working hard on ideas on member retention, community events and other activities for the Lodge and WOTM members. We want to make sure that we are up and running at the end of this pandemic and able to continue helping our children at Mooseheart and our seniors at Moosehaven.

Moose Lodge 808 and WOTM 1141 are still alive with the Covid-19 virus shutting down our State, City and Lodge for any community events, general membership meetings, donation dinners and other Lodge actives.

The Board of Officers started a new community event on Monday, March 30, 2020 for our members only. We are "buying meat and other supplies from one of our Lodge restaurant suppliers and then selling it to our members at the same price". To get this price for goods, contact one of the officers (toilet paper is also available).

The Queen of Hearts, Roll-A-Day, Pick-A-Card and Daily Draw funds have been totaled and deposited and will be set back up with the SAME amount of money when the Lodge 808 is reopened.

The fire damaged kitchen has been repainted, new fire rated ceiling tile and a new fire rated grid system is being installed. The contractors for the removal of the fire damaged stainless steel wall covering and cleaning of the ducts have been waiting for the Notice to Proceed from the Adjuster at ENGLEMARTIN & ASSOCIATES. I believe the Notice to Proceed will be given to our Lodge within the first week of April. Construction will take about 30 days to complete. The Vent and Ancil system for the Stove and Fryers will take about 6 to 8 weeks to be delivered and 3 days to install.

The officers of Lodge 808 will be having classes on OSHA Standards, Health Standards and Fire Standards for the volunteers that will be working in the Lodge kitchen. Classes will be held after the lock-down is over.
