The study also revealed that in only three of the 21 months since 5/1/21 did we experienced a month-over-month membership increase.

I am attending a membership building and retention workshop at Red Rock Lodge on April 8. I hope to come back from the workshop with some fresh, new, innovative ideas for combating membership decline.

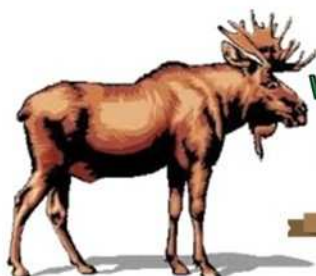

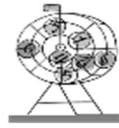
The 2nd Thursday of every month from 4:00 to 7:00 we celebrate. If it is your Birthday month, you get one free drink.

Bingo Update Moose Charities



12/6/22 – 2/6/23

During this bimonthly newsletter reporting period, in-house fund raising collected a total of \$2,425.19 for Moose Charities and local charitable giving.
