Kitchen orders will be accepted up to 15 minutes prior to the regularly scheduled closing time. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the kitchen crew. When the Kitchen is closed Bar Food can be purchased from the bartender on duty.

If you are frequently in the Lodge, you can arrange to pick up your newsletter in the Social Quarters, or you can receive it online. If you receive multiple newsletters at your residence, please let the Administrator at [lodg808@mooseunits.org](mailto:lodg808@mooseunits.org) or the Treasurer at [chapter1141@mooseunits.org](mailto:chapter1141@mooseunits.org) for know how you would like to receive your newsletter in the future, and this will help to cut the bi-monthly printing and mailing costs.

Queen of Hearts: You must be an active Member of Pahrump Moose Lodge 808 and show your card when purchasing tickets. **Tickets are to be filled out in the Lodge. They may NOT leave the premises.** In the event you select a winning card you must show your valid membership card before receiving your prize.

**On May 1, 2021, Moose International joined men and Women together as ONE MOOSE. In the ensuing years we are simply referred to as THE MOOSE. All females active at the time of the change were given 3 free years of dues (\$15) to their Chapter. Men were still required to pay their \$15 dues to belong to the Legion. For woman, if you were NOT a lifetime member when we became One Moose you are required to be a member of the Lodge and those dues are \$55 per year. You cannot just be a member of the Chapter or the Legion. YOU MUST FIRST BE A MEMBER OF THE LODGE. If you are not a paid in full member of the Lodge, you are not allowed in the Social Quarters or at meetings and your membership card will not open the doors. These rules have come from Moose International and must be followed if we wish to maintain our charter and our tax-exempt status. If the bartender on duty or a Board Member asks to see your card you are required to show it. Everyone should always be proud to show their card when entering any Moose Home.**

**Why should I continue to pay Chapter dues? Just like the Legion, the Chapter provides the steppingstone to all the higher degrees that you can attain. The WOTM do many things for Mooseheart and Moosehaven. Each Chapter provides monetary help for scholarships, medical and pharmacy needs, educational needs, school pictures, Christmas gifts and all the little extras. Additionally, Chapters adopt a child at Mooseheart and grandparents at Moosehaven and surprise them with some extra special gifts for birthdays, anniversaries, Christmas and graduation. Without the Women of the Moose, life would not be as sweet at our Twin cities. So, the next time you get a notice from Moose International whether for Lodge or Chapter or Legion dues please pay them promptly so that we can continue to provide the necessary support for our children and seniors.**

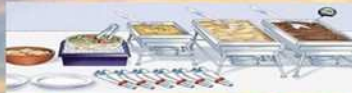

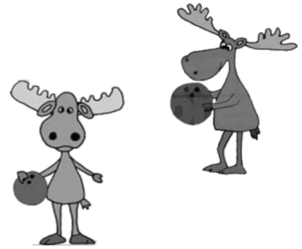
Thanks to kitchen manager, Mike and his crew for stepping up to offer this.

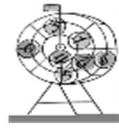

## *Bingo Update Moose Charities*



**2/7/23 – 4/10/23**

During this bimonthly newsletter reporting period, in-house fund raising efforts collected a total of \$2,937.13 for Moose Charities and local charitable giving.

Of this total, \$601.59 came from Bank on Our Kids, \$164.54 came from 9 o'clock ceremonies, \$2,161 came from bingo, and \$10 came from an individual donation.

In addition to the above-mentioned normal and recurring charitable fund raising activities, we donated \$100 for the Moosehaven wi-fi upgrade project, Association President Henderson's special project, and our Moose Riders activity group donated \$100 for Mooseheart home furnishings and equipment, the item at the top of Mooseheart's wish list. Both checks were presented during the march of checks at the CNMA midyear conference in March.

On April 9th, Territory Manager Copp presented me with a report detailing our lodge's total overall charitable giving through Moose Charities for 2022 – 2023 year to date. For the first time ever, we have smashed through the \$10,000 mark, thanks to YOU, our caring, generous, and dedicated Moose members. Be proud of yourselves, as I am, to be a member of the Moose Fraternity – the most awesome organization on earth.
