New Moose ID Cards

Many of you have complained that the new Moose ID cards issued since May 1 do not work. They do work; they are just different from the old cards in that they do not have a magnetic strip on the back. The magnetic strip has been replaced by a QR code. Simply hold the back of your card facing the QR code scanner about six inches away from it. The door will buzz immediately for you to pull it open.

Capital Projects

We have raised \$25,198, or 84% of the \$30,000 goal for replacing the leach lines. I have submitted a lodge improvement grant application to Moose International for the remainder.

Once we get the leach lines done, I would like to replace the floor in the social quarters with the same or similar flooring that we have in the dining room. The tile flooring in the social quarters is badly cracked and pitted in several places, especially around the gaming machines and the pool table nearest the machines. As always, we will greatly appreciate donations for this project.
