On August 13th we reached and exceeded our fundraising goal for the stove, thanks to all of you who graciously donated toward it, amounts small and large. I don't have enough room to individually thank each of you. You know who you are. I do want to thank the member, who loaned us enough money interest-free for six months, enabling us to order the stove right away. Thanks to your donations and our hugely successful donation dinner on August 10th, we were able to pay them back in full on August 13th, more than five months ahead of schedule. Speaking of August 10th, what a day it was! We hosted Smiles Across Pahrump in the morning and the donation dinner in the afternoon. Both events were enormously successful. Thanks to Chanda Wieland and her cadre of volunteers for Smiles Across Pahrump. Thanks to the joint Lodge and Chapter officers and their army of volunteers for the donation dinner, as well as a Chapter member who wishes to remain anonymous for hiring the Dean West Smokin' Gun Band for entertainment throughout the donation dinner. 
