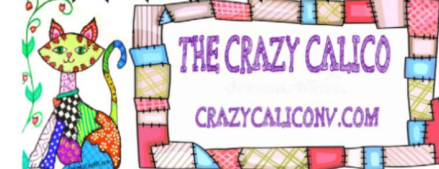

Our new kitchen stove has been ordered and shipped as of this writing. We expected it to be delivered the week of August 11th. On August 13th we reached and exceeded our fundraising goal for the stove, thanks to all of you who graciously donated toward it, amounts small and large. I don't have enough room to individually thank each of you. You know who you are. I do want to thank the member, who loaned us enough money interest-free for six months, enabling us to order the stove right away. Thanks to your donations and our hugely successful donation dinner on August 10th, we were able to pay them back in full on August 13th, more than five months ahead of schedule.

Speaking of August 10th, what a day it was! We hosted Smiles Across Pahrump in the morning and the donation dinner in the afternoon. Both events were enormously successful. Thanks to Chanda Wieland and her cadre of volunteers for Smiles Across Pahrump. Thanks to the joint Lodge and Chapter officers and their army of volunteers for the donation dinner, as well as a Chapter member who wishes to remain anonymous for hiring the Dean West Smokin' Gun Band for entertainment throughout the donation dinner.

I have submitted a grant request to Moose International for funds totaling \$22,329.38 for four projects: (1) a separate, enclosed smoking area, (2) the new stove, (3) an air conditioning unit for the kitchen, (4) ceiling insulation throughout the building.

I have some individuals I must thank for helping me and our Lodge home out in big ways: Steve Newman and Steve Darny, Jr. for much needed repairs and improvements to our home; Gary Underdahl for obtaining price quotes for the smoking area and the new stove; Ron Breault for pruning trees, whacking weeds, and cleaning up our yard.
